13.5 (B)(Cont'd)

New Customers

New Customers will be billed at 72% of the full energy, demand and RKVA rates under this Service Classification.

Existing Customers

Upon demonstrating load growth of 500 kW or greater within 12 months at their current facility, the Company will establish a base year of billing units for energy and demand, which will be the customer's last complete calendar year at their current facility. The base year energy and demand units will be billed at full rates under this Service Classification. Customers' growth over the base year in energy and demand will be billed at 72% of the full rates specified under this Service Classification.

Energy Supply Charge

All electricity provided and sold by the Company under Special Provision 13.5 (B) will be subject to the Energy Supply Charge as defined in General Information, Section 29; however, this discount shall not apply to the Energy Supply Charge. Customers participating in the Retail Access Program as described in General Information Section 35 shall not be subject to this charge.

Term of Provision

Special Provision 13.5(B) will expire on June 30, 2001. All discounts will cease on June 30, 2001, at which time customers will be billed at full rates under this Service Classification. The Company reserves the right to review the appropriateness of the 75,000 kW load limit during the term of this provision. The Company's review will consider its ability to continue to offer growth incentive discounts given anticipated load and capacity needs.
