3.6 ECONOMIC GROWTH INCENTIVE DISCOUNT (Cont'd)

Term of Provision

Special Provision 3.6 will expire on June 30, 2001. The Company reserves the right to review the appropriateness of the 75,000 Kw load limit during the term of this provision. The Company's review will consider its ability to continue to offer growth discounts given anticipated capacity needs.

3.7 BUSINESS RETENTION DISCOUNT

- A) **Applicability:** This Business Retention Discount is applicable to any existing non-governmental customer served under S.C. Nos. 2 and 3 having a minimum load of 250 kW and (a) is classified in Standard Industrial Classification - Major Groups 20-51 and 60-89; and (b) where certification is provided from the NY State Department of Economic Development (DED) indicating the customer has satisfactorily documented that Comprehensive Tax or Economic Incentives and the Business Retention Discount are both necessary to retain the customer in New York State. To be considered for certification by DED, the customer must satisfactorily document one or more actual, impending relocation opportunities outside New York State that would significantly reduce the operating costs of the customer. The customer must also document the existence of Comprehensive Tax or Economic Incentives from local and/or State authorities.
- B) **Scope of Program:** Power available under the Business Retention Discount for S.C. Nos. 2 and 3 (Special Provisions 2.10 and 3.7 respectively) customers will be capped according to the following schedule of cumulative power:
