Marketer Election of Alternative Billing Arrangement

- a. A Marketer may express an interest to act as a billing entity by contacting the Company*s Transportation Services Department. The request by the Marketer to act as a billing entity must be submitted with sufficient notice to allow the requisite review, approvals, and testing prior to initiation of the Marketer Single Bill Option.
 - (1) Marketers approved to act as a billing entity must notify the Company of its intent to begin this service at least ten (10) calendar days prior to the next scheduled meter read date of the first customer to be switched to the Marketer Single Bill Option.
 - (2) Once the application is received by the Company, the Marketer must also meet the requirements set forth in the Marketer/Direct Customer Eligibility section of this Service Classification.
 - (3) The Company may terminate the Marketers* right to offer an Alternative Billing Arrangement after providing five (5) calendar days* notice to the Marketer if:
 - (i) The Marketer fails to meet and maintain creditworthiness requirements as set forth in this Service Classification.
 - (ii) The Marketer fails to meet the rules set forth in the Performance Standards Section of this Service Classification.
 - (iii) The Marketer has failed, after notice from the Company, to meet the obligations as set forth in this tariff and/or any other applicable agreement (s) with the Company subject to the Dispute Resolution rules as set forth in this Service Classification.
