CUSTOMER BILLING ARRANGEMENTS

I. DEFINITIONS

<u>Alternative Billing Arrangement</u> shall mean billing methods that allow a Retail Access Customer to receive either a Single Bill or a Consolidated Bill.

<u>Bill Ready</u> shall mean each party calculates its own charges, inclusive of all taxes and surcharges, and shall present such charges to the bill presenter.

<u>Billing Services Agreement</u> shall mean the standard form of agreement between the Company and the ESCO/Marketer for an Alternative Billing Arrangement setting forth the duties, responsibilities, and obligations of the Company and the ESCO/Marketer, which must be executed and delivered by the ESCO/Marketer as a condition of either the Company or the ESCO/Marketer providing a Single Bill or a Consolidated Bill.

<u>Combination Customer</u> shall mean a Customer with a common company account for both gas and electric service.

<u>Consolidated Bill</u> shall mean a bill combining delivery, commodity and other related charges for a Combination Customer when one or more of the commodity and other services are provided under Retail Access.

<u>Dual Billing Arrangements</u> shall mean the billing method in which a Retail Access Customer receives a Company rendered bill for the service it provides and an ESCO/Marketer rendered bill for the services it provides.
