Customers converting to gas space heating without complying with the Company's minimum insulation requirements, Rule 4.10.3, or found in non-compliance with the appropriate minimum insulation requirements for new dwellings Rule 4.10.2, will be required to pay a surcharge of 25 percent of their total bill for electric and/or gas services. Refer to Rules 4.10.2.5 or 4.10.3.4, Penalties for Non-compliance, for the application of the surcharge.
- D. Budget bills will be computed in accordance with Rule 15.7.6.
- E. Qualified low income customers will be eligible for a minimum charge of \$8.55.
