RESIDENTIAL SERVICE (continued)

INCREASE IN RATES AND CHARGES:

The rates and charges under this service classification, including Monthly Delivery Service, Monthly Cost of Gas and minimum charge, will be increased by a tax factor pursuant to Rule 19.

TERMS OF PAYMENT:

Bills are due and payable. Full payment must be received on or before the date shown on the bill to avoid a late payment charge of one and one-half percent (1 1/2%) pursuant to Rule 15.2.

TERM:

For residential service without building heating, customer may terminate service after three days notice to Company. For all other service, one year and thereafter until canceled. This annual term provision will not apply in instances where delivery service customers are involuntarily switched back to sales service.

SPECIAL PROVISIONS:

- A. Written application may be required. See Paragraph 2.1 of Rules and Regulations.
- B. Whenever service is supplied where extension of distribution main facilities for service is requested, construction will be in accordance to Rule 10 of this schedule.
- C. Customers converting to gas space heating without complying with the Company's minimum insulation requirements, Rule 4.10.3, or found in non-compliance with the appropriate minimum insulation requirements for new dwellings Rule 4.10.2, will be required to pay a surcharge of 25 percent of their total bill for electric and/or gas services. Refer to Rules 4.10.2.5 or 4.10.3.4, Penalties for Non-compliance, for the application of the surcharge.
- D. Budget bills will be computed in accordance with Rule 15.7.6.
- E. Qualified low income customers will be eligible for a minimum charge of \$8.55.
