D. Delivery Point

In the event a location has more than one electrical retail delivery point (delivery point), each delivery point will require a metering device. The charges described under RATE:, will apply to each delivery point. For the purposes of this service classification, the delivery point is the point of attachment of Company owned conductor(s) to the conductor(s) owned by the customer.

E. Inspection

Customer's equipment and wiring shall be approved by a competent, duly authorized inspection agency. The Company shall approve the installation and may restrict the type of equipment to be installed on existing wood poles. Connection to Company's system shall be made only by Company's personnel or its designees.

F. Warranty

Company is not responsible, by inspection, if any, or non-rejection, nor in any other way give warranty, expressed or implied, for the adequacy, safety or other characteristics of any structures, equipment or wires owned, installed or maintained by customer or leased by customer from third parties.

G. Tree Trimming

As a condition of receiving service, the customer authorizes the Company, insofar as it lawfully may, to trim, cut, remove and to keep trimmed, cut and removed any trees and all other obstructions which, in the opinion of the Company, interfere with or may tend to interfere with the construction, operation and maintenance of the Company's service. Tree trimming required for light visibility is the responsibility of the customer, and shall be done by the customer or at customer's expense.

H. Ancillary Equipment

Only equipment used for purposes directly related to traffic control or enforcement of same (e.g.: cameras, etc.), as determined by the Company will receive electrical power from the traffic control supply and be served by this service classification.

I. Discontinuance of Service

Company shall have the right to discontinue service to any customer owned equipment which in the opinion of Company shall have become unsatisfactory for further service by reason of deterioration, civil commotion, state of war, explosion, fire, storm, flood, lightning, or any other cause reasonably beyond Company's control.
