2. Application for Water Service
 - A. Written application for service may be required.
 - B. A separate application may be required for each premises and a separate service must be installed for each premises. The word "premises" as used herein shall be restricted to the following:
 - (1) A building under one roof owned or leased by one customer, and occupied as one residence or one place of business or,
 - (2) A combination of buildings owned or leased by one customer, in one common enclosure occupied by one family or one firm as one residence or one place of business; or
 - (3) Each unit of a multiple house or building separated by a solid vertical partition wall occupied by one family or one firm as one residence or one place of business; or
 - (4) A building owned or leased by one customer having a number of apartments, offices or lofts which are rented to tenants and using, in common, one hall and one or more means of entrance; or
 - (5) A building, two or more stories high, under one roof owned or leased by one customer having an individual entrance for the ground floor occupants and one for the occupants of the upper floors.
- C. Premises may be subject to inspection by the company.
- D. Applications not accepted from customers in arrears. No agreement will be entered into by the company with any applicant for water service until all arrears and charges due from the applicant for water service until all arrears and charges due from the applicant for water service at any premises now or heretofore owned or occupied by him in the territory supplied by the company shall have been paid.
- E. Service pipe installations are subject to company approval.
- F. Shut-off of joint service. Where two or more premises are supplied with water through one service pipe under the control of one curb stop, if any of the parties so supplied shall violate any of these rules, the company reserves the right to shut off the joint service line, except that such action shall not be taken until the innocent customer, who is not in violation of the company's rules has been given a reasonable opportunity to attach his pipe to a separately controlled service connection.
