SPECIAL PROVISIONS (Cont'd)

21.2 FULL RETAIL ACCESS WITH 5% RATE REDUCTION EQUIVALENT (Cont'd)

When a customer's monthly maximum demand is equal to or less than the customer's rate reduction equivalent, the total power and associated energy will be billed under the rates and charges of this provision.

When a customer's monthly maximum demand exceeds the customer's rate reduction equivalent, the portion that will be billed under the rates and charges of Special Provision 21.2 shall be determined as follows:

- A Rate Reduction Ratio will be calculated by comparing the rate reduction equivalent to the customer's actual monthly measured demand;
- 2. The portion of the customer's demand served under Special Provision 21.2 will be the customer's rate reduction equivalent;
- 3. The portion of the customer's on- and off-peak energy served under Special Provision 21.2 will be the product of the Rate Reduction Ratio and the on- and off-peak kilowatt-hour usages for the month;
- 4. The balance of the customer's total registered demand and energy supplied by the Retail Supplier and delivered by the Company will be billed at the full monthly rates specified above. The basic and peak period demands to be supplied by the Customer's Retail Supplier shall be the product of one minus the Rate Reduction Ratio and the total demand in each of the respective periods. The energy to be supplied by the Customer's Retail Supplier in the onand off-peak time periods shall be the product of one minus the Rate Reduction Ratio and the total kilwatthours in the respective time periods.

Customers electing to take service under this provision will be required to execute a Requirements Contract with Central Hudson.
