21.1 PARTIAL REQUIREMENTS (Cont'd)

4. The balance of the customer's total registered demand and energy will be supplied by the Company and billed at the appropriate rates and charges of Service Classification No. 13. The basic and peak period demands to be billed shall be the product of one minus the Retail Access Ratio and the total demand in each of the respective periods. The energy to be billed in the on- and off-peak time periods shall be the product of one minus the Retail Access Ratio and the total kilowatt-hours the in respective time period.

Customers electing to take service under this provision will be required to execute a Requirements Contract with Central Hudson for the remainder of their energy and capacity requirements which will be served under Service Classification No. 13, including the Company's Energy Value Option Plan set forth in Special Provision 13.7.

21.2 FULL RETAIL ACCESS WITH 5% RATE REDUCTION EQUIVALENT

Any customer who (a) qualifies to take service under this classification and (b) wishes to purchase all of its energy and capacity requirements from a provider (Retail Supplier) other than Central Hudson may elect to obtain a portion of its energy and capacity requirements, equivalent to the 5% rate reduction described in Special Provision 13.8 applied to the customer's load characteristics, under this provision. Such rate reduction equivalent will be based on a customer's load characteristics for the most recently completed calendar year unless the customer can demonstrate a significant change in their load.

Energy, demand and RKVA rates for the portion of a customer's load served under this provision will be billed at the full monthly rates specified above, except for the Competitive Transition Charge component which will be billed at 50% of the full monthly rates specified above.
