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SERVICE CLASSIFICATION NO. 21 (Cont'd)

<u>LARGE POWER SUBSTATION AND TRANSMISSION SERVICE - RETAIL ACCESS PROGRAM</u> (Cont'd)

SPECIAL PROVISIONS

The numbering of the paragraphs hereunder begins with the above service classification number.

21.1 PARTIAL REQUIREMENTS

Any customer who (a) qualifies to take service under this classification and (b) wishes to purchase only a portion of its energy and capacity requirements from a provider (Retail Supplier) other than Central Hudson may elect to obtain from a Retail Supplier, the retail access equivalent of the 5% rate reduction described in Special Provision 13.8 applied to the customer's load characteristics. Such retail access equivalent will be based on a customer's load characteristics for the most recently completed calendar year unless the customer can demonstrate a significant change in their load.

Energy, demand and RKVA rates for the portion of a customer's load served under this provision will be billed at the full monthly rates specified above, except for the Competitive Transition Charge component which will be billed at 50% of the full monthly rates specified above.

When a customer's monthly maximum demand is equal to or less than the customer's retail access equivalent, the total power and associated energy will be billed under the rates and charges of this provision.

When a customer's monthly maximum demand exceeds the customer's retail access equivalent, the portion that will be billed under the rates and charges of Special Provision 21.1 shall be determined as follows:

- A Retail Access Ratio will be calculated by comparing the retail access equivalent to the customer's actual monthly measured demand;
- 2. The portion of the customer's demand served under Special Provision 21.1 will be the customer's retail access equivalent;
- 3. The portion of the customer's on- and off-peak energy served under Special Provision 21.1 will be the product of the Retail Access Ratio and the on- and off-peak kilowatt-hour usages for the month;
