MINIMUM CHARGE:

The customer charge for small commercial customers. The demand charge, as defined in "DETERMINATION OF DEMAND," for large commercial customers.

DETERMINATION OF DEMAND:

- A. The demand will be determined by meter when three phase service is supplied or when the total connected load is equivalent to 15 KW or more; or when the customer's consumption has exceeded 2,000 kilowatt hours in each of two consecutive months; or when it is estimated that a new customer's consumption will exceed such an amount in future billing periods.
- B. When demand is so determined by measurement, the billing demand shall be the highest 15 minute integrated demand established in the billing period, but not less than 75% of the highest demand established during the preceding 12 months or 15 kilowatts.

TERMS OF PAYMENT:

All bills are due when rendered. Full payment must be received on or before the date shown on the bill to avoid a late payment charge of 1.5% as provided in Rule VIII of the NYMPA generic tariff.
