10. PURCHASED POWER ADJUSTMENT:

The charges set forth in this Service Classification shall be subject to a Purchased Power Adjustment Clause, as explained in the NYMPA generic tariff.

11. <u>TERMS OF PAYMENT</u>:

Net cash on presentation of bill. A monthly Delayed Payment charge of 1-1/2% on a customer's unpaid balance will be assessed if paid after Due Date shown on bill.

12. <u>DELAYED PAYMENT</u>:

Non-payment of the bill on or before the Due Date shown on the monthly bill shall result in a Notice of Late Payment and a Notice of Disconnection. Such said Notice of Disconnection shall be made in writing in a format in accordance with the New York State Law, Title 21, Section 459.4. Non-payment on or after fifteen calendar days after the Due Date shown on the bill may cause the service to be disconnected. Such service shall remain disconnected until such time that the Delayed Payment bill and any applicable reconnection charges have been paid in full or satisfactory arrangements made for payment of same.

In the case of multi-family dwellings with master metering, an additional Notice of Disconnection shall be posted in a public area of the dwelling in accordance with Title 21, Section 459.6 of the New York State Law, on or after the twenty days after first Notice of Disconnection has been served. At the time of posting of said notice, separate Disconnection Notices shall be sent to each of the family units within the dwelling.
