Character of Service:

Gas Service provided under this Service Classification shall be on an interruptible basis. In providing service under Service Classification, the Company will, upon four hours notice (or one hour notice in the case of system emergency), interrupt deliveries of gas to any or all Customers taking service under this Service Classification whenever and to the extent that it may be advisable in the Company's judgement. This includes interruptions in order for the Company to obtain exemption from curtailment under the Company's pipeline suppliers' curtailment plans.

Rate: (per meter per month)

The Effective Rate per therm for the four categories below shall be established at the discretion of the Company, but will not to exceed the lowest terminal rate of Service Classification No. 3, plus the Gas and Pipeline Costs and Adjustments (Ceiling Price); or be lower than the adjusted average cost of gas for interruptible service (Floor Price).

However, effective immediately and, whenever the Floor Price exceeds the Ceiling Price, the Company shall endeavor, on a best efforts basis, to provide gas to such sales customers at an Interim Rate equal to the Company's Incremental Cost of Gas plus \$0.10/dth, excluding taxes. exception in no way relieves the customer of his alternate fuel oil requirements as stated on Leaf No. 129, Section vi.
