## **Service Classification No. 4B:**

- (a) For new Service Classification No. 4B customers the applicable monthly distribution rates for gas service in excess of 200 therms per month shall be reduced by an amount equal to 35% in excess of 200 therms. Monthly consumption less than or equal to 200 therms shall be billed at the applicable Service Classification No 4B rates and charges.
- (b) For customers presently taking service under Service Classification No. 4B the rate reductions shall only apply to that portion of the customer's monthly consumption in excess of their established base consumption described herein and shall be computed in the manner described above.
- (c) All monthly gas consumption not meeting the discount qualifications of this Rider shall be billed at the applicable Service Classification No. 4B rates and charges.

## Service Classification No. 6C:

Available for service rendered from May 1st through October 31st only.

- (a) For new customers the applicable monthly rates for gas service in excess of 1250 therms per month shall be reduced by an amount equal to 35% of the net margin described under Service Classification No. 11, TS-6C on Leaf No. 239.
- (b) For customers presently taking service under Service Classification No. 6C the rate reduction shall only apply to that portion of the customer's monthly consumption in excess of their established base consumption described herein and shall be computed in the manner described above.
- (c) All monthly gas consumption not meeting the discount qualifications of this Rider shall be billed at the applicable Service Classification No. 6C rates and charges.
