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GENERAL INFORMATION - Continued

- (b) Service to any other new customer for any use will be permitted only where customer has full facilities to burn an alternative fuel. It shall be the sole responsibility of the customer to install and maintain adequate alternative facilities and fuel. Such service will be provided at the sole option of the Company and may be interrupted at the sole option of the Company.
- (c) Service to existing customers, other than to existing customers in one and two-family homes and other domestic customers which are individually metered, that take less than 12,420 dth annually shall be limited to a maximum of (1) 12,420 dth per year or (2) 120 percent of the highest annual consumption in any one of the last three years, whichever is less. Additional gas may be provided only where the customer has dual-fuel capacity at least equal to the customer's installed incremental capacity above such ceiling. Such incremental use shall be subject to interruption at the option of the Company.  
Conversion to the use of gas for space heating in existing structures, other than one and two-family homes already using gas for other purposes, is considered a new attachment and is not permitted under this provision.
- (d) Service to existing customers using in excess of 12,420 dth per year shall be limited to such customer's highest annual consumption in the past three calendar years. Additional gas may be provided only where the customer has dual-fuel capacity at least equal to the customer's installed incremental capacity above such ceiling. Such incremental use shall be subject to interruption at the option of the Company.
- (e) Service may be terminated to customers who violate the applicable demand ceilings cited in paragraphs (c) and (d) above, upon approval of the Public Service Commission. Prior gas use in Mcf will be converted to dth units by application of a conversion factor of 1.035 for all limitations.
