## II. Rules and Regulations (continued):

### 1--Definition of Terms (continued):

#### M

Main: A pipeline located on a public or private right-of-way which is generally available or used to transport gas to more than one service line.

Margin-Interruptible Service: Interruptible sales revenues less gross revenue taxes and the cost of gas. The cost of gas is the average cost of gas for the month of sale plus an estimated operating expense of 0.1 cents per therm multiplied by the total interruptible sales in that month.

Margin-Tail Block: Tail block rate per therm for a given Service Classification less the base cost of gas contained in that rate.

Maximum Interruptible Hourly Quantity: One hundred percent of an interruptible transportation customer's hourly rating for the equipment listed as Attachment A to the Interruptible Transportation Service Agreement at the time of application for service under Service Classification No. 7 or as subsequently modified pursuant to a written agreement between the Company and the interruptible transportation customer.

Maximum Interruptible Daily Quantity: One hundred and fifty percent (150%) of an interruptible transportation customer's Interruptible Daily Quantity.

Monthly Delivered Quantity: The amount of natural gas that the Company estimates that a firm Customer will use in a calendar month.

#### N

Non-Core Customer: A customer who has and chooses to utilize alternatives to natural gas. If a customer chooses to be a non-core customer for a specific application or end-use, such application must be separately metered. Service to non-core customers is provided under Service Classification Nos. 4 and 7.

#### O

Operational Flow Order: Actions taken by the Company to control system operations.

#### P

Payment: A payment is considered to be made on the date it is received by the Company or one of its authorized agents.
