Special Provisions:

- (a) For purposes of this Schedule for Gas Service, cogeneration means the sequential production of electricity and/or mechanical energy and useful form of thermal energy from a single input energy source.
- (b) Prior to receiving gas service under this service classification, consumers shall be required to certify to the Company that installed cogeneration equipment would meet the requirements for qualification under Part 292 of title 18 of the Code of Federal Regulations or as a "cogeneration facility" as defined in Section 2 of the New York Public Service Law.
- (c) The Company reserves the right to accept only such applications under this service classification as will, in the Company's sole judgement, permit it to dispose of the gas it has available for sale without requiring an unreasonable or uneconomic extension of facilities.
- (d) Exemption from the limitation provisions set forth in Special Provision (c) hereof will be granted by the Company provided that a contribution payment for capital costs incurred to make the attachment is submitted prior to the commencement of gas service by the applicant for such gas service.
