Rate Schedule 2:

Customers whose annual weather normalized usage is equal to or greater than 10,000 dth

A monthly minimum charge of \$294.71 for the first 10 therms consumed will be applied to each customer under this rate schedule. No later than three days prior to the end of each month, the Company will file with the Public Service Commission a unit commodity rate per therm applicable to all sales exceeding the minimum consumption of 10 therms per month, to become effective on the first day of the following month. The Company will, at its sole discretion, set the rate per therm at a level which is no less than the Company's Incremental Cost of Gas as filed with the Public Service Commission and no higher than the lesser of (1) 115% of the No. 2 oil gas equivalent price, inclusive of any petroleum related taxes applicable to commercial or industrial use, or (2) the tailblock rate of Service Classification No. 2 (General Service - Non-Residential) - Rate Schedule 1 (Non-Heating) inclusive of the applicable Monthly Cost of Gas less \$.01, and no lower than 85% of the No. 6 oil, .3% sulfur gas equivalent price. A separate rate will be posted for customers who demonstrate to the Company's satisfaction, that they are exempt from payment of the New York State (NYS) Petroleum Business Tax (PBT) for fuel oil consumption.

The No. 6 oil, .3% sulfur gas equivalent price and the No. 2 oil gas equivalent price shall be determined as set forth in Rate Schedule 1. The monthly per therm rate set for Rate Schedule 2 shall not be higher than the monthly per therm rate set for Rate Schedule 1.
