**Rate TS-5LR (Interruptible Load Retention Service Transportation - Individually Negotiated):**

**Applicability:**

Interruptible gas transportation service to any existing industrial customer operating a plant within the Company's service territory: (1) currently receiving service under Rate TS-5 to Service Classification No. 11; (2) whose minimum annual requirements of gas is at least 600,000 Dth and the ratio of the daily average usage to the maximum rated daily input is greater than or equal to 50%; (3) whose final total production cost includes at least 7.5% gas costs; and (4) which has demonstrated a need for a load retention rate, as detailed below.

**Character of Service:**

See Service Classification No. 11, Leaf No. 235.

**Service Agreement:**

The rate and terms of TS-5LR service shall be the subject of an individual contract negotiated between the Company and the customer. The Company may consider, in determining the customer's eligibility for an individually negotiated rate as well as the actual rate, if eligible, the extent of the customer's efforts to reduce its other costs and improve on the efficiency of its energy usage. The terms of service shall include, but not be limited to: (1) primary term (not less than three years, may be renegotiated); (2) rates and charges for service; and (3) any other individually negotiated characteristics of service. Summaries of contract information will be available in Contract Addenda contained in this Tariff. Negotiated contracts at similar overall terms shall be available to all similarly situated customers.
