TERMS OF PAYMENT:

Payment of bills due on or before the 26th day of the month following that for which the bill is rendered. Bills paid after the 26th day will be subject to a 1.5% late Charge.

All bills are due when personally served or three days after the mailing of the bill and may be paid without imposition of a charge for late payment if paid in full on or before the last day to pay date specified on the bill which shall be at least 20 days after the date on which the bill is rendered.

A monthly late payment charge will be assessed at a rate of one and one-half percent (1½%) per month on a customer's unpaid balance, including service billing arrears and unpaid late payment charges, Remittance mailed on the "last day to pay" date will be accepted without the late payment charge, the postmark to be conclusive evidence of the date of mailing. The failure on the part of the customer to receive the bill shall not entitle him/her to pay without the late payment charge after the last day to pay date.

PURCHASED POWER ADJUSTMENT:

The charges set forth in this service classification shall be subject to a purchased power adjustment as explained in the NYMPA generic tariff.

The charges billed under this section shall be subject to the late payment rate.

Retail Customer Power-Factor Regulation/Tariff Provision

Customer shall maintain a power factor at the point of delivery of not less than 90% lagging or leading as measured on a 30 minute basis. If customer is notified that their power factor has fallen below 90%, corrective action must be taken within 30 days. If action is not taken, the necessary corrective equipment will be installed by the Village of Richmondville and the customer will be billed for all costs incurred to correct the power factor to the required level.
