LOW INCOME RESIDENTIAL ASSISTANCE SERVICE - Continued

The conservation credit will be subject to the following conditions:

- 1. the customer shall not have changed residences during the period of time between the end of the billing cycle for which the credit is being computed and the beginning of the billing cycle one year earlier;
- 2. the customer shall have paid all prior bills of the Company under this rate schedule (although the Company may waive this condition if nonpayment resulted from unusual circumstances); and
- 3. the credit for any billing month shall not exceed the amount of the bill for service under this rate schedule exclusive of the conservation credit.

UTILITY LOW INCOME ENERGY EFFICIENCY PROGRAM (ULIEEP) SURCHARGE:

The rates in this Service Classification shall be increased by the ULIEEP surcharge, as described in General Information Section 39.

GAS ADJUSTMENT:

The charges set forth herein, including charges specified under Special Provisions of this Service Classification, shall be subject to a gas adjustment per 100 cubic feet of gas supplied hereunder when changes from Base Cost of Gas occur (as explained on Leaf Nos. 74-84).

Default service under this service classification shall be subject to the GAC monthly adjustment, as set forth in General Information Section 19.

FIXED PRICE OPTION ("FPO"):

ENROLLMENT -

When available, the FPO shall be offered to all customers under Service Classification Nos. 1, 2 and 3. Each year the FPO is offered, an enrollment period shall commence on or about October 1 and shall end on the late payment date for the last control (billing) cycle in October. The FPO shall be applied to participating customers* bills for a five-month period beginning in December and ending in April. Customers shall be notified of the FPO by newspaper publication and/or bill insert, or such other cost-effective means as determined by the Company upon consultation with the Public Service Commission, Consumer Services Division. Enrollment shall be limited to the total number of customers that can be served, based on the Company*s forecast load requirements, from the pool of supply secured under dedicated fixed price contracts included in the Company*s gas portfolio for the winter period, but in no case shall the FPO be offered to less than ten percent (10%) of customers by each qualified service class. That number shall be reported to the Consumer Services Division prior to the commencement of the enrollment period.
