SERVICE CLASSIFICATION 3 (LARGE COMMERCIAL RATE) (CONT'D)

Taxes:

The bill, as calculated in the above rate structure, shall be increased by a percent equal to that paid to the State of New York and Madison County as a sales tax.

TERM:

One year. Thereafter, service may be disconnected at the request of the customer by presentation of thirty (30) days notice and payment of the minimum charge for the remainder of the billing period, if any.

After the term of one year within this service classification, a customer may be moved into Service Classification 2 if both the customer's energy consumption and demand fall below 6,000 kWh per month and 10 kW respectively for any three consecutive months.

PURCHASED POWER ADJUSTMENT:

The charges set forth in this service classification shall be subject to a purchased power adjustment as explained in the NYMPA generic tariff.
