## LATE OR DELAYED PAYMENT:

A monthly late payment charge will be assessed at the rate of one and one-half (11/2 %) percent per month on a customer's unpaid balance, including service billing arrears and late payment charges. Remittance mailed on the "last day to pay" date will be accepted without the late payment charge, the postmark to be conclusive evidence of the date of the mailing. The failure on the part of the customer to receive the bill shall not entitle him/her to pay without the late payment charge after the "last day to pay" date.

If the monthly bill is not paid on or before thirty-five (35) days after the "due date" shown on the bill, the Commission shall initiate procedures to disconnect service until such time as the delayed payment bill and any applicable charges have been paid. Further information is found in the General Information section of the Electric Service Rules and Regulations of the Commission.

## TAXES:

The bill, as calculated in the above rate structure, shall be increased by a percent equal to that paid to the State of New York and Madison County as a sales tax.

## TERM:

One year. Thereafter, service may be disconnected at the request of the customer by presentation of thirty (30) days notice and payment of the minimum charge for the remainder of the billing period, if any.

## PURCHASED POWER ADJUSTMENT:

The charges set forth in this service classification shall be subject to a purchased power adjustment as explained in the NYMPA generic tariff.
