If the monthly bill is not paid on or before thirty-five (35) days after the "due date" shown on the bill, the Commission shall initiate procedures to disconnect service until such time as the delayed payment bill and any applicable charges have been paid. Further information is found in the General Information section of the NYMPA generic tariff

## TAXES:

The bill, as calculated in the above rate structure, shall be increased by a percent equal to that paid to the State of New York and Madison County as a sales tax.

## TERM:

One year (12 months) commencing at the date of installation, and thereafter, from year to year until canceled at the request of the customer by presentation of thirty (30) days' notice.

## PURCHASED POWER ADJUSTMENT:

A. The Commission shall also provide a cable service span of one hundred (100) feet which shall be connected an the line side of the customer's meter. Where the service span exceeds one hundred feet, the customer shall pay for the additional cable used.
