CHARACTER OF SERVICE

Continuous, Alternating current, 60 Cycles, Single and Three Phase, 120/240 Volts, two or three wire of three phase 240 volt, where demand is metered.

DETERMINATION OF DEMAND

The active demand shall be the maximum 15 minute integrated demand occurring during the month for which charge is made, but not less than one kilowatt.

TERMS OF PAYMENT

All bills are due when personally served or three days after the mailing of the bill and may be paid without imposition of a charge for late payment if paid in full on or before the "last day to pay" date specified on the bill which shall be at least 20 days after the date on which the bill is rendered.

A monthly late payment charge will be assessed at a rate of one and one-half percent (1 ½%) per month on a customer's unpaid balance, including service billing arrears and unpaid late payment charges, Remittance mailed on the "last day to pay" date will be accepted without the late payment charge, the postmark to be conclusive evidence of the date of mailing. The failure on the part of the customer to receive the bill shall not entitle him/her to pay without the late payment charge after the "last day to pay" date.
