## **GENERAL INFORMATION**

#### SECTION IV. INSTALLATION OF SERVICES

#### 1. Definitions

## a. Public Street

For the purposes of these rules a public street is defined as any street, avenue, road or way that is for any highway purpose under the jurisdiction of the legislative body of any village, town, city, county or the State of New York.

### b. Private Street

For the purposes of these rules a private street is defined as any street, avenue, road or way that is not for any highway purpose under the jurisdiction of the legislative body of any village, town, city, county or the State of New York.

#### c. Any highway purpose

The Company will recognize any street, avenue, road or way as being for highway purposes under the jurisdiction of the legislative body of any village, town, city, county or the State of New York, if any one of the following three conditions is satisfied:

- If the street has been dedicated and accepted by the legislative body, or
- 2) If the street has been condemned by the legislative body, or
- 3) If the street is being maintained by the legislative body at the time application for water service is received.

# 2. Public Streets - Owner or Occupant

Upon receipt of proper application from an owner or occupant of any property abutting on a public street as hereinbefore defined, the Company will furnish, place, construct, operate, maintain and when necessary, replace at its own cost and expense the service pipe and connections within the territorial limits of the public street.

#### 3. Public Streets - Stub Service

Whenever, at the request of an owner or occupant of any property abutting on a public street as hereinbefore defined, a service pipe is provided through which service is not immediately desired, said property owner or occupant shall bear the cost of providing, placing and constructing the service pipe and accessories, but he shall be entitled to a
