GENERAL INFORMATION

SECTION V. INSTALLATION OF METERS

1. An individual meter shall be required for each premises and for each separate service connection to a premises.
2. The meter will be furnished and connected by the Company without cost to the customer. The Company reserves the right in all cases to stipulate the size, type and make of the meter to be used on any connection.
3. Whenever possible, a meter two inches (2") in size and under shall be set in the basement. The meter shall be located at a convenient point approved by the Company so as to protect the meter and to measure the entire supply of water through the connection. When a meter cannot be set in the basement it will be set at or near the property line or in a place designated by the Company and all expenses incurred by the Company in connection with its proper housing shall be reimbursed to the Company.

Meters larger than two inches (2") shall be set at or near the property line or in a place designated by the Company and all expenses incurred by the Company in connection with its proper housing, including by-pass for testing, if required, shall be reimbursed to the Company.

In all cases, irrespective of meter size, where the distance from the property line to the front wall of the building is greater than seventy-five (75) feet, the Company may require that the meter be set at or near the property line.

When, due to special circumstances, it is necessary to set any meter within the territorial limits of a public street, all expenses in connection with the proper housing of the meter will be assumed by the Company. Housings located in public streets will be maintained by the Company at its expense.

4. All meters and meter connections shall at all times remain the sole property of the Company, and shall not be interfered with in any respect. All meters will be maintained by and at the expense of the Company so far as ordinary wear and tear are concerned but the customer will be held responsible for damages due to freezing, hot water or other external causes. In case of damage the Company will repair
