exceed deliveries by more than 2-15% as specified in the OFO. When a Forced Balancing OFO is imposed for overdeliveries, an aggregator's deliveries must not exceed usage by customers for whom the aggregator is providing Pooled Balancing Service by more than 2-15% as specified in the OFO. Aggregators will be assessed a penalty of \$2.50 per day, per therm for imbalances that exceed the OFO limit.

c. Changing Aggregators. A Customer may change aggregators effective on the first day of any month by providing notice to Niagara Mohawk on **Aggregator Form 2** no less than 21 days prior to the requested effective date of the change. **Aggregator Form 2** must be signed by the Customer and the Customer's new aggregator. If the term of the Customer's service agreement with the current aggregator, as specified on **Aggregator Form 2** submitted to Niagara Mohawk, has not expired as of the effective date of the change of aggregators, Niagara Mohawk will notify the current aggregator of the change, and will comply with the instructions of the Customer.
