DEFINITIONS: (continued)

(a) Under Deliveries - The therm balance remaining when aggregate usage of the customers in the aggregator's pool during the month is greater than the total deliveries of gas to the Niagara Mohawk system by or on behalf of the customers in the pool during the month.

(b) Over Deliveries - The therm balance remaining when aggregate usage of the customers in the aggregator's pool during the month is less than the total deliveries of gas to the Niagara Mohawk system by or on behalf of the customers in the pool during the month.

(c) Maximum Peak Day Quantity (MPDQ) means the maximum quantity of gas that the customer may take on any winter day. Customer's MPDQs will be calculated according to the Base and Thermal Methodology.

BILLING QUANTITY:

The amount of gas to be billed each month under this Service Classification will be the amount of gas consumed by the Customer during the billing period.
