- (c) Additional Non-Residential Conditions for Termination: (Cont'd)
  - 2. fails to pay amounts due under a DPA;
  - fails to pay a lawfully required security deposit in accordance with Section 8.O. of this Schedule:
  - 4. fails to provide reasonable access to the premises for necessary or proper purposes in connection with rendering of service, including meter installation, reading or testing, or the maintenance, or removal, or securing, of the Company's property, and the Customer has not advised the Company that the Customer does not and who does have control over access; or
  - 5. fails to comply with a provision of the Company's Schedule which permits the Company to refuse to supply or to terminate service.
  - (ii) The Company may terminate service to a customer without providing advance notice of the termination and without fulfilling the other requirements of this section when it finds service being supplied through tampered equipment provided that the Company:
    - has evidence that the Customer opened the account and used the service prior to the creation of the condition or that the Customer knew, or reasonably should have known, that service was not being fully billed;
