DEFINITIONS: (continued)

BILLING QUANTITY:

The amount of gas to be billed each month under this Service Classification by the Company to the Customer will be the Total Monthly Billing Quantity. The Total Monthly Billing Quantity may consist of one or more of the following amounts.

(a) The Monthly Delivery Quantity will be the amount of gas billed each month associated with the transportation portion of the service.

(b) The Monthly Nominated Standby Quantity will be the amount of gas billed each month associated with the standby sales portion of the service.

(c) The Daily Elected Contract Demand will be the maximum daily level of standby service elected by the Customer regardless of whether transport or sales service is actually taken.

DEFINITION OF RATES:

1. Firm Transportation Service

A) Applicable to eligible customers formerly served by NMSuburban Gas Inc. under Service Classification No. 5 of P.S.C. No. 1 Gas.

First 100 Therms or less	\$350.00
Over 100 Therms, per Therm	\$.04500

B) All other customers.

First 100 Therms or less	\$700.00
Over 100 Therms, per Therm	.05154

C) All customers taking firm transportation under this service classification will be subject to a monthly balancing rate per therm calculated in accordance with Rule 17.12 of this tariff multiplied by their Maximum Peak Day Quantity reduced by the amount of the customer's Daily Elected Contract Demand.
