STATEMENT OF TERMS:

A statement of the major contract terms of each Service Agreement executed pursuant to this Service Classification will be duly filed with the Public Service Commission, apart from this rate schedule, as soon as is practicable after the contract is executed. The statement will be available to the public at the Company's offices at which application for Service may be made.

INCREASE IN RATES AND CHARGES:

The rate and charges under this Service Classification will be increased by a tax factor pursuant to Rule 19 in the General Information Section of the P.S.C. No. 218 Gas tariff.

TERM:

The initial term and renewal options shall be as provided for in the Service Agreement, but in no case less than one year.

TERMS OF PAYMENT:

Bills are due when rendered. Full payment must be received on or before the date shown on the bill to avoid a late payment charge of one and one-half percent (1 1/2 %).

MINIMUM ANNUAL BILL:

The customer will be billed for the applicable Contract Year's Minimum Annual Delivery Quantity minus the sum of the twelve (12) Monthly Delivery Quantities plus any quantity for under delivery taken under Special Provision G multiplied by the then effective Company transportation rate, as per the Service Agreement. Customers whose Service Agreement provides for a demand component in addition to the variable commodity component may, at the sole discretion of the Company, be given waiver of the Minimum Annual Bill requirement under this paragraph.

SPECIAL PROVISIONS:

A. The Company will install, at the Customer's expense, the necessary electronic metering equipment, acceptable to the Company, which allows the Company to monitor the Customer's daily usage of gas.
