CAPACITY BROKERING

APPLICABLE TO USE OF SERVICE FOR

The assignment of firm or recallable transportation capacity on upstream pipeline(s) available to Central Hudson Gas & Electric Corporation will be available to all eligible customers, and other parties subject to the availability of capacity to be assigned.

The assignment of transportation capacity rights on upstream pipelines shall be at the sole discretion of the Company within the requirements of the specific upstream pipeline(s) policies and procedures and the valid requirements of governmental and regulatory authorities having jurisdiction over such transactions.

DEFINITIONS

- 1. The Company means Central Hudson Gas & Electric Corporation.
- 2. Eligible customer means a firm or interruptible transportation customer, who has executed a Capacity Assignment Agreement.
- 3. Assignee means any person who has purchased the Company's available capacity.
- 4. Subsequent Assignee means a replacement shipper who enters into a contract with Assignee in order to take possession of capacity. The subsequent assignee remains subject to the pipeline's operational provisions as stated in the pipeline tariff.
- 5. Maximum Daily Quantity (MDQ) means the maximum quantity that the Assignee can transport to the Delivery Point on any day as specified in Notice of Assigned Capacity. The MDQ on the Notice of Assigned Capacity for eligible customers can not exceed the MDQ specified on their gas transportation contracts.
