30. DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE: (CONT'D)

- C. Discontinuance of Service by a Marketer to an Individual Customer - Non-Daily Metered Customers (Cont'd)
- (3) Switch requests received subsequent to the discontinuance notice will be verified in accordance with Section 28.A. of this Schedule.
- D. Discontinuance of Service by a Marketer to an Individual Customer - Daily Metered Customers
- (1) A Marketer may discontinue service to individual customers in the Company's service territory at will, upon submission of a notice to those individual customers and to the Company at least fifteen (15) calendar days prior to the discontinuance date. The discontinuance date shall be the applicable switch date as set forth in Section 27 of this Schedule. The form and content to be provided in the written notice is fully set forth in the Gas Transportation Operating Procedures Manual.
- (2) If the Marketer does not give the required notice to its customers and the Company, the Marketer may be determined ineligible by the PSC and/or may be assessed a monetary penalty by the PSC.
- E. Involuntary Discontinuance of a Marketer's/Pool Operator/Aggregation Pool Operator/Direct Customer's Service Rights
- (1) The Company may initiate a process to discontinue a Marketer's/Pool Operator's/Aggregation Pool Operator's/Direct Customer's rights under this Schedule:
- (a) where the Company determines that it is necessary or desirable for safety of system reliability reasons. An illustrative listing is contained in the Gas Transportation Operating Procedures Manual;
- (b) where the Marketer/Pool Operator/Aggregation Pool Operator/Direct Customer fails to comply with the terms of this Schedule or other agreements with the Company;
- (c) where there is a continued pattern of unauthorized switching (Slamming);
