(3) Billing Arrangement Election Fees: (Cont'd)

- (b) There will be no charge for an involuntary change to Dual Billing.
- (c) An election fee of ten dollars (\$10) will be charged to the Customer when

such Customer notifies the Company of its choice to return to Dual Billing.
- (d) An election fee of ten dollars (\$10) will be charged to the ESCO/Marketer for all elections not excluded by items in Section 32.E.(3)a, 32.E.(3)b and 32.E.(3)c above.
- (e) In the event that a Retail Access switching fee is applicable at the same time as a billing arrangement election fee, only one (1) fee of ten dollars (\$10) will be assessed to the requesting party.
- (f) Each change to the billing arrangement, after the first election, will be deemed voluntary unless the ESCO/Marketer and/or the Customer can provide information to the Company to establish the election as involuntary. Further detail is set forth in the Gas Transportation Operating Procedures Manual. Any discrepancies regarding the voluntary or involuntary nature of an individual Customer's election may be addressed by the appropriate process for disputes as set forth in the Gas Transportation Operating Procedures Manual.

F. Billing Functions:

- (1) The entity that issues the Single/Consolidated bill will be responsible for the following billing functions:
 - (a) printing and mailing Single/Consolidated Bills; and
 - (b) printing standard bill messages and mailing bill inserts required or authorized by law, regulation or the PSC; and
 - (c) providing for a minimum of four hundred forty-four (444) characters for printing standard bill messages; and
