# Rider H – VOLUNTARY CLEAN ENERGY PROGRAM (Applicable to Service Classification Nos. 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5)

## A. Applicability

This program is offered by the Company, to assist Customers that receive service pursuant to the Service Classifications listed above, in complying with applicable emissions laws, rules, or regulations or in otherwise reducing greenhouse gas emissions.

### **B.** Definition

"Qualifying GHG Reduction Measure" is an incremental measure intended to reduce greenhouse gas emissions associated with provision of steam by the Company. Qualifying GHG Reduction Measures are limited to clean fuel purchases, environmental attribute products (e.g., renewable energy credits or carbon offsets) or Company operating changes.

# C. Description of Service

Subject to the availability of Qualifying GHG Reduction Measures, an eligible Customer may enter into an individually negotiated service agreement with the Company under which Con Edison will purchase one or more Qualifying GHG Reduction Measures on the Customer's behalf or the Customer will contribute in whole or in part to the incremental cost of a Qualifying GHG Reduction Measure that is an operating change. Payments to Con Edison under the negotiated service agreement will be in addition to the Customer's normal payments for service under the Customer's applicable Service Classification.
