Net Metering and Value Stack Tariff for PASNY Customer-Generators - Continued

Charges and Credits - Phase One NEM

- 1. Charges to a PASNY Customer Served Under Phase One NEM
 - a. The PASNY Customer will pay the rates and charges of the PASNY Customer's applicable rates for net energy supplied by the Company. If the PASNY Customer is served under time-of-day ("TOD") rates, the charge for net energy supplied by the Company will be determined for each time period.
 - b. A PASNY Customer served under this Section shall pay any customer charge or minimum charge, and any other rates and charges under the PASNY Customer's applicable rate regardless of whether the amount of energy produced by the generating equipment is less than, equal to, or greater than the amount of energy used by the PASNY Customer. A PASNY Customer taking demand-billed service shall pay kW delivery charges based on the maximum demand delivered by the Company to the PASNY Customer during the billing period.
 - c. The PASNY Customer will be exempt from the Minimum Monthly Charge for Rate I and II under the General Provisions section of this Rate Schedule. A PASNY Customer served under both this Net Metering and Value Stack Tariff for PASNY Customer-Generators and Rider Y of the Schedule for Electricity shall be subject to all Rider Y terms and conditions, except that Contract Demand will not be used to determine demand delivery charges.
- 2. Credits to a PASNY Customer Who Supplies Net Energy to the Company
 - a. For Non-Demand Billed PASNY Customers

For PASNY Customers with solar, wind, micro-hydro, electric generating equipment at their premises, any kWhr of net energy provided to the Company during the billing period will be applied as a kWhr credit towards any net kWhr used during the succeeding billing period.

b. Remote Net Metering and Community Distributed Generation

A PASNY Customer under Phase One NEM cannot participate in Remote Net Metering or Community Distributed Generation.
