3.2 SERVICE OPTIONS, (CONTINUED)

3.2.4 Option 4 (MAXCESS I)

Option 4 is a one-way, intrastate multipoint service, designed for very high-volume users. Option 4 customers may originate calls via voice grade special access or high capacity (T1) access arrangement provided by the customer between the customer's premises and Carrier's switch. The Company reserves the right to limit service availability to Option 4 customers with a minimum requirement for 17 voice grade equivalent channels.

a) Rate Structure

Charges for Option 4 service are based on length of call, time of day, and distance.

b) Usage Charges

The Carrier's Option 4 service is based on the airline distance between the originating and terminating locations of each call. Usage is measured in six second increments. Any fraction of an increment is rounded up.

c) Ancillary Services

Calls made to Directory Assistance are charged on a per call basis.
