#### **3.2 SERVICE OPTIONS**

##### **3.2.22 Option 26 - Flex Connect 8XX**

Flex Connect 8xx is a shared, inward switched service which permits inbound calls, originated by dialing an 8xx number to terminate at a Multipoint 8xx customer's common line (i.e., business line), provided a valid Personal Identification Routing Number (PIRN) is entered by the caller. The Flex Connect 8xx customer is billed for the call rather than the call originator. Flex Connect 8xx service completes calls to a Carrier assigned 8xx telephone number. The PIRNs entered by the caller determine the customer's designated telephone number to which the 8xx call will terminate. Upon request, from one to a maximum of ten PIRNs may be assigned by the Carrier to the customer excluding those PIRNs reserved for special use by the Carrier. Requests for four or more PIRNs are subject to credit approval by the Carrier. Flex Connect 8xx service employs shared telephone numbers and, by conversion to Flex Connect 8xx service, the Flex Connect 8xx customer releases any ownership or exclusive rights of its 8xx telephone number to the Carrier.

Charges for Flex Connect 8xx service are assessed based on the time of day and length of call.
