TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES TARIFF

SECTION 2 - RULES AND REGULATIONS, (CONT'D.)

2.15 Refusal or Discontinuance by Company

The Company may refuse or discontinue service under the following conditions. Unless otherwise stated, the Customer will be given notice and allowed a reasonable time to comply with any rule or remedy any deficiency.

- 2.15.1 For non-compliance with and/or violation of any State or municipal law, ordinance or regulation pertaining to telephone service.
- 2.15.2 For the use of telephone service for any other property or purpose other than that described in the application.
- 2.15.3 For failure or refusal to provide the Company with a deposit or advance payment to insure payment of bills in accordance with the Company's regulations or failure to meet the Company's credit requirements.
- 2.15.4 For neglect or refusal to provide reasonable access to the Company for the purpose of inspection and maintenance of equipment owned by the Company.
- 2.15.5 For non-compliance with and/or violation of the Commission's regulations or the Company's rules and regulations on file with the Commission, provided five (5) working days' written notice is given before termination.
- 2.15.6 For non-payment of bills for telephone service. Suspension or termination of service shall not be made without five (5) working days' written notice to the Customer, except in extreme cases.
- 2.15.7 Without notice in the event of Customer use of equipment in such a manner as to adversely affect the Company's equipment or the Company's service to others.
