RIDER L - DIRECT LOAD CONTROL PROGRAM - Continued

G. Customers or Tenants with Room Air Conditioners Receiving a Control Device From the Company

Customers or Tenants may elect to receive a maximum of four Control Devices from the Company for their Room Air Conditioners. For Customers or Tenants that elect to receive Control Devices from the Company, each Control Device will become the property of the Customer or Tenant following participation in a full Event without opting out prior to or during the Event. Manually adjusting the Control Device thermostat during an Event will constitute opting-out of the Event.

Customers or Tenants with enrolled Control Devices for Room Air Conditioners in the program may receive financial incentives payable as reward points that may be redeemed for gift cards or a donation to charity through an online platform. See Table 1 for incentive details.
