SERVICE CLASSIFICATION NO. 4 (CONT'D)

NATURAL GAS MOTOR VEHICLES (CONT'D)

SPECIAL PROVISIONS:

- 1. For Category 1 customers, the expense of installing facilities necessary to separately meter service provided hereunder shall be borne by the Customer.
- 2. Gas supplied hereunder may, under certain circumstances, contain a mixture of natural gas and liquefied petroleum gas.
- 3. Gas service supplied at Company-owned and operated compressor stations is subject to the Company's sole determination that sufficient capacity exists at its compressor stations to adequately serve Company and Customer Natural Gas Vehicle requirements.
- 4. The Company reserves the right to accept an application under this service classification as shall, in the Company's sole judgement, permit it to sell the gas it has available for sale without requiring any extension of or additions to its compressor station facilities located on Company premises. In no event shall the Company be obligated hereunder to construct additional compressor stations.
- 5. When on Company premises, the Customer must observe all applicable Company safety regulations. The maximum delivery pressure for the CNG shall be clearly displayed at the refueling station.
- 6. Budget Billing not available to customers under this service classification.
- 7. The Company may, at its sole discretion, adjust the prices charged customers that are exempt from any vehicle fueling taxes. Such adjustments shall be made on a non-discriminatory basis, such that, any tax exempt customers within the same rate area and rate category receive the same tax adjustments.
- 8. Compressed Natural Gas (CNG) sold at Company-owned compressor stations shall be measured in pounds and converted to Ccf by multiplying the pounds by a factor of 0.2250.
- 9. For Category 1 customers, the operating costs of the compressor including electric charges, are the responsibility of the customer.
