Section 6- RESIDENTIAL NETWORK SWITCHED SERVICES

6.1 <u>GENERAL</u>

- 6.1.1 Residential Network Switched Service provides a residential customer with a single, analog, voice-grade telecommunications connection to the Company's switching network which enables the customer to:
 - a) place and receive calls from other stations on the public switched telephone network;
 - b) access the Company's local, regional and toll calling service;
 - c) access the Company's operators and business office for service related assistance; access tollfree telecommunications services such as 800 NPA; and access 911 service for emergency calling;
 - d) access the service of providers of interexchange service. A customer may presubscribe to such provider's service to originate calls on a direct dialed basis or to receive 800 service from such provider, or may access a provider on an ad hoc basis by dialing the provider's Carrier Identification Code (10XXX).
 - e) each access line can be used to place or receive one call at a time. Access lines are provided for connection to a single, customer-provided station set or facsimile machine.
