#### 2.12 AUTOMATIC NUMBER IDENTIFICATION

## 2.12.1 Regulations

The Company will not provide services over the leased fiber backbone and therefore does not anticipate connectivity into the PSTN. The Company's service offering will consist of a "Dark" Fiber path configured in point to point and/or ring configurations. Should the services provided by the Company expand to include voice and voice related services, the Company will file the appropriate Tariff amendments to include Automatic Number Identification (ANI) as per the requirements of the Commission.

## 2.13 EMERGENCY/CRISIS/ DISASTER RESTORATION AND PROVISIONING-TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICE PRIORITY

#### 2.13.1 General

The Company will not provide leased line services directly to customers and therefore will not directly be impacted by the Emergency/Crisis/Disaster Restoration and Provisioning Telecommunications Service Priority (TSP) Program. We will however provide fiber optic capacity to carriers who are subject to this Program. The Company will cooperate fully with our customers to provide information as required by the Program to meet the stated objectives of the Program.
