SERVICE CLASSIFICATION NO. 6

FIRM TRANSPORTATION RATE - Core (Cont'd)

INCREASE IN RATES AND CHARGES

The rates and charges under this service classification are increased pursuant to General Information, Section 28 to reflect the tax rates applicable within the municipality where the customer takes service.

Transportation Demand Adjustment

In addition to the Monthly Rate, customers taking service under Service Classification No. 6 will be charged a rate per Ccf equal to the sum of the Balancing Adjustment and Capacity Assignment Adjustment, as described below. The above charges shall be adjusted for pipeline credits, the Capacity Release Credit, the Interruptible Sales Credit and the Gas Research and Development Surcharge as defined in General Information Section 27.

- (1) The Balancing Adjustment will be equal to zero.
- (2) The Capacity Assignment Adjustment, as described in General Information, Section 41, shall apply to all gas consumed.

Merchant Function Charge, System Benefits Charge, Gas Bill Credit and Revenue Decoupling Mechanism

The charges set forth herein shall be subject to the Merchant Function Charge, System Benefits Charge, Gas Bill Credit and Revenue Decoupling Mechanism Adjustment as explained in General Information Section 42.

Weather Normalization

The charges set forth herein may be subject to a Weather Normalization Adjustment as explained in General Information, Section 27.
