### 4.4 Calling Plans

7. CenturyLink Freedom (f/k/a 8 Cents Plan) (7AZ)

A customer who subscribes to the CenturyLink Freedom Plan will pay a flat Per Minute rate on all Dial-1 domestic calls, 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

When a customer subscribes multiple lines to the CenturyLink Freedom Plan, at least one of every two lines must be provided by a CenturyLink LOC. For example, when a customer subscribes to this service for either three or four lines, at least two of those lines must be provided by a CenturyLink LOC. The customer's lines may be at the same or different locations provided that the eligibility requirements are met.
