- 3.2 Service Options (Continued)
  - Excel Calling Card Service: Excel's Calling Card Service provides for the completion 3.2.7 of toll calls between two points when the Customer is away from his or her premises. The Customer will be assigned a unique travel authorization code(s) that authorizes the use of Calling Card Service by that Customer. Customers will receive a Calling Card for use in accessing Excel's services when away from their telephones. The appropriate designated access number sequence specified on the Customer's Excel Calling Card must be dialed.
  - Directory Assistance: The underlying carrier provides service to Excel to offer 3.2.8 directory assistance services which the Customer may access by dialing the area code plus 555-1212. Customer will be billed for such service by Excel, except as stated in this tariff.
  - **3.2.10** Excel Operator Service: Excel's Operator Services permits callers to bill a call to an account which is not associated with the Customer's presubscribed telephone. Such calls are initiated by callers when a "0" precedes the called telephone number. Operator services include collect, third party, calling card and person-to-person calls. This service is only offered where Equal Access is available.
  - **3.2.11** Prepaid Service: Under this arrangement, callers to use Excel's services on a prepaid basis. Customers may purchase a prepaid calling card from an authorized representative for a specified amount. Charges for telephone calls are then deducted from the prepaid account balance.
