## GENERAL INFORMATION

### 12. System Benefits Charge (SBC)

- A. Each customer bill for service under the applicable Service Classifications will be increased by multiplying all Therms delivered by a surcharge rate (as shown in the System Benefit Charge (SBC) Statement). The surcharge will be calculated on an annual basis to collect the Corporation's allocated fund amount as set forth in the Orders based on year by year projections of the following year's gas sales. Any over- or under-collections will be trued up on an annual basis. This surcharge is comprised of the following components:
1. Pursuant to Commission *Order Establishing Energy Efficiency Portfolio Standard and Approving Programs*, issued and effective June 23, 2008, and *Order Approving Certain Commercial and Industrial Customer Energy Efficiency Programs with Modifications*, issued and effective October 23, 2009, in Case 07-M-0548, and
  2. Pursuant to Commission *Order Authorizing Utility-Administered Gas Energy Efficiency Portfolios for Implementation Beginning January 1, 2016*, issued and effective June 19, 2015, in Cases 07-M-0548 and 15-M-0252.
- B. Applicability  
The SBC will be applicable to residential and non residential customers taking service under Service Classification Nos. 1, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, and 9.
- C. System Benefits Charge (SBC) Statement setting forth the annual rate will be filed with the Public Service Commission on not less than three (3) days' notice. Such statement shall be readily accessible to the public.
