A Seller aggregating imbalances for two or more Interruptible or Off-Peak Firm Service Classification No. 9 Customers shall pay the following charges per therm:

Daily Surplus Imbalance Charge:

For any day on which the Daily Delivery Quantity is less than the Daily Transportation Quantity, the Seller shall pay a Surplus Imbalance Charge for the excess quantity, on a per therm basis, based on the daily balancing tiers as specified in the GTO and as shown on the Statement of Balancing Service Charges.

Daily Deficiency Imbalance Charge:

For any day on which the Daily Delivery Quantity is greater than the Daily Transportation Quantity, the Seller shall pay a Deficiency Imbalance Charge for the deficiency quantity, on a per therm basis, based on the daily balancing tiers as specified in the GTO and as shown on the Statement of Balancing Service Charges.

Daily Imbalance Charges shall not be applicable during an OFO period, during which the Seller is subject to Charges for Unauthorized Use.
